

## Shueyville City Council Meeting – May 12, 2020

Mayor Coonfare called the regular monthly meeting of the Shueyville City Council to order at 6:30 pm on Tuesday, May 12, 2020 in the council chambers at the Shueyville Community Center.

**Roll Call** – Council present in chambers: Mickey Coonfare, Brent Foss  
Council present by phone due to the Coronavirus: Bart Frisk, Becky Neuhaus and Chris Lacy  
Absent: Brad Anderson (resigned)

Governor Reynolds issued a “Stay in place” order and limited social gathering to less than 10 people. To comply with this order only one Council Member, Mayor, City Clerk and City Engineer were present in council chambers. Other members were present by telephone and the council chambers was open to the public.

**Citizen’s Comments Items not on Agenda:** a citizen asked about who will take care of sidewalks on Curtis Bridge Road when the project is completed. It was stated that it would be the home owner’s responsibility to maintain the sidewalks in front of their home inside the city limits.

**Consent Agenda:** No comments on: Agenda, Minutes from April 14, 2020 Council Meeting, Treasurer’s Report or Claims. Sheriff report: 36 items, 1 traffic, 3 susp/theft, 0 bar check, 22 fire/medical, 10 other. Permits 3017 Forest Ridge Drive, new home. Neuhaus motioned, seconded by Foss to approve the Consent Agenda consisting of the Agenda, April 14, 2020 Minutes, Summary List of Claims, Licenses/Permits, and Treasurer Report. All Ayes, motion carried 4-0.

**Business:** Curtis Bridge Road Reconstruction is on schedule. It has been difficult to keep up with the temporary road but they will continue to do what they can to maintain it.

Motion by Foss, seconded by Neuhaus to approve change order no 2 for \$22,437.10 for Curtis Bridge Road Reconstruction. All ayes, motion carried 4-0

Motion by Foss, seconded by Neuhaus to approve pay estimate no. 2 for \$244,691.21 for Curtis Bridge Road Reconstruction. All ayes, motion carried 4-0

Motioned by Lacy, seconded by Frisk to approve Resolution 2020-16 Allowing Mayor to enter into a contract for lawn mowing services. Roll call vote: Ayes-Frisk, Foss, Lacy, and Neuhaus. Nays- none, motion carried 4-0

Motioned by Foss, seconded by Neuhaus to open the public hearing for possible budget amendment #1 for FY20. No comments. Motioned by Foss, seconded by Neuhaus to close the public hearing. All ayes, motion carried 4-0

Motioned by Neuhaus, seconded by Foss to approve Resolution 2020-18 Approving the city’s proposed amendment #1 to the FY20 budget. Roll call vote: Ayes-Foss, Neuhaus, Lacy and Frisk, Nays- none, motion carried 4-0

Motion by Neuhaus, seconded by Frisk to approve Resolution 2020-19 Approving transfer of funds to pay principal and interest on GO bond loan payment. Roll call vote: Ayes-Frisk, Foss, Lacy, and Neuhaus. Nays- none, motion carried 4-0

Motioned by Foss, seconded by Neuhaus to accept the resignation of Brad Anderson from Shueyville City Council effective immediately. All ayes, motion carried 4-0

Motioned by Neuhaus, seconded by Foss to set a public hearing for June 9, 2020 to discuss a replacement and fill the vacate Shueyville City Council seat. All ayes, motion carried 4-0
