611 INSTALLATION OF TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES. The City Council shall establish by resolution, and cause to be placed and maintained, appropriate traffic control devices to indicate parking spaces and zones, no parking zones, limited parking zones, reserved parking zones, loading zones, safety zones, school zones, hospital zones, quiet zones, traffic zones other than the above, truck routes, school stops, stop intersections, yield right-of-way intersections, one-way streets, streets to be laned for traffic, and play streets. The Council shall also have the power to designate and indicate by resolution intersections at which traffic shall be controlled by traffic signals; intersections at which left turns, right turns and U-turns shall be prohibited; and intersections at which markers, buttons or other indications shall be placed to indicate the course to be traveled by vehicles traversing or turning at such intersections. The City shall keep a record of all such traffic control devices.

612 COMPLIANCE. No driver of a vehicle shall disobey the instructions of any official traffic control device placed in accordance with the provisions of this chapter, unless at the time otherwise directed by a peace officer, subject to the exceptions granted the driver of an authorized emergency vehicle under Section 321.231 of the *Code of Iowa*.

613 CROSSWALKS. The City Council is hereby authorized to designate and maintain crosswalks by appropriate traffic control devices at intersections where, due to traffic conditions, there is particular danger to pedestrians crossing the street or roadway, and at such other places as traffic conditions require.

614 TRAFFIC LANES. Where traffic lanes have been marked on street pavements at such places as traffic conditions require, it is unlawful for the operator of any vehicle to fail or refuse to keep such vehicle within the boundaries of any such lane except when lawfully passing another vehicle or preparatory to making a lawful turning movement.

615 STANDARDS. Traffic control devices shall comply with standards established by *The Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices for Streets and Highways*.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall become effective July 9, 2019.

On the 11 day of June, 2019, at a regular meeting of the Shueyville City Council, Shueyville, Iowa, Councilperson Neuhaus introduced Ordinance Chapter 61 Traffic Control Devices, and moved that it be given its first reading. The motion was seconded by Councilperson Frisk.

4 members of the Council being present and having voted "Aye", Mayor Mickey Coonfare declared the motion carried, and Ordinance, Chapter 61 Traffic Control Devices was read the first time and discussed and placed on record.

On the 9 day of July, 2019, at a regular meeting of the Shueyville City Council, Shueyville, Iowa, Councilperson Foss introduced Ordinance Chapter 61 Traffic Control Devices, and moved that it be given its second reading and to waive the 3rd reading and final reading and place Chapter 61, Traffic Control Devices on its final reading. The motion was seconded by Councilperson Neuhaus.

Absent: Anderson

4 members of the Council being present and having voted "Aye", Mayor Mickey Coonfare declared the motion carried, and Ordinance, Chapter 61 Traffic Control Devices was read a second time and waived the 3rd reading and place it on its final reading.

On the 9 day of July, 2017, at a regular meeting of the Shueyville City Council, Shueyville, Iowa, thereupon, it was moved by Councilperson Lacy and seconded by Councilperson Foss that Ordinance Chapter 61 be placed on its final passage and adopted

Nays: none

Absent: Anderson

4 members of the council being present and having voted "Aye", Mayor Mickey Coonfare declared the motion carried, and Ordinance Chapter 61 Traffic Control Devices was then placed passed and adopted.

Whereupon the Mayor declared that Ordinance Chapter 61 Traffic Control Devices be adopted and signified her approval of same by fixing her signature thereto.

Passed council on the 9th day of July 2019 and approved by the Mayor on the 9th day of July 2019.
