

## Shueyville City Council Meeting – May 10, 2022

Mayor Coonfare called the regular monthly meeting of the Shueyville City Council to order at 6:32 pm on Tuesday, May 10, 2022, in the council chambers at the Shueyville Community Center.

**Roll Call** – Council present in chambers: Mickey Coonfare, Becky Neuhaus, Chris Lacy, Patty Stephens, Brent Foss. Absent: Bart Frisk

**Also present:** Dave Schechinger, Leah Kolar, Randy Russell, Janice Horak, Wayne Becicka

**Citizen's Comments, Items not on Agenda:** Questions about patrolling the STOP sign at the corner of Southview and Skyview were discussed. Questions about whether Shueyville's Iowa House District has changed due to a mailer received by a citizen- confirmed Shueyville is in Iowa House District 77 and Iowa Senate District 39. Questions about when road construction work would be completed on Club Road up to county line- Johnson County scheduled for next year but will check back to confirm.

**Consent Agenda:** Comments on building permit #706 for garage construction at 1302 Southview Lane NE: this permit was revoked at the previous council meeting due to failure to meet proper setback requirements set forth by City Code of Ordinances. The application was resubmitted, and new construction plans have confirmed proper setbacks. Questions about the plat for this property were discussed- confirmed a plat is on file with Johnson County Assessor's Office. Discussed new "Notice of Responsibility" attached to all building permits and permit applications. Comments on Johnson County Sheriff's Report: no report was sent/received. No comments on: Agenda, Minutes from April 12, 2022 Council Meeting, Summary List of Claims, Treasurer/ Clerk's Report for April 2022, Licenses/Permits issued: 1; permit #705, single family home construction. Motioned by Foss to approve the Consent Agenda except for the Johnson County Sheriff's Report as it was not received for discussion, seconded by Neuhaus. All Ayes, motion carried 4-0.

### Business:

- A. Motioned by Neuhaus, seconded by Foss to approve Resolution 2022-10; Approving Transfer of Funds for Loan Payments, Roll Call, all ayes, motion carried 4-0
- B. Discussion on use of American Rescue Plan Funds of \$48,805.25.
  - 1) Planning for community CPR classes to be held at Community Center. Dates TBD. Stephens motioned to approve up to \$10,000 of American Rescue Plan Funds to pay for CPR classes and equipment to be housed at Jefferson Monroe Fire Department. Seconded by Neuhaus. All ayes, motion carried.
  - 2) Lacy reported information for purchase of AED for Community Center. AED manufacturer, Zoll, will include the defibrillator, case, set of spare pads, and service to replace pads. Stephens motioned to approve up to \$2000 of American Rescue Plan Funds to pay for AED for Community Center, seconded by Neuhaus. All ayes, motion carried.
- C. Discussion of culvert flagged for work on James Ave. City Engineer confirmed this is not a culvert flagged for work. This is a control point for MMS Surveying.

### Correspondence, Announcements & Comments:

- Notices from State of Iowa, City Development Board RE: annexation of land parcels into City of Swisher- all parcels are on West side of 380.
- Johnson County Board of Supervisors opposing proposed carbon pipelines that would run through 36 Iowa counties, not including Johnson County.
