

Shueyville City Council Meeting – January 10, 2023

Mayor Coonfare called the regular monthly meeting of the Shueyville City Council to order at 6:34pm on Tuesday, January 10, 2023, in the council chambers at the Shueyville Community Center.

Roll Call – Council present in chambers: Mickey Coonfare, Bart Frisk, Patty Stephens, Chris Lacy. Absent: Brent Foss.

Consent Agenda: No comments on the meeting agenda, minutes from previous meeting, list of claims, Treasurer/Clerk's report for December, Johnson County Sheriff's report, and no permits or licenses were issued. Neuhaus motioned to approve the consent agenda; Frisk seconded. All ayes, motion carried.

Business:

- A. Neuhaus motioned to set a public hearing to address the annual maximum property tax levy in Shueyville. Frisk seconded the motion. All ayes- motion carried. - B. Council reviewed drafted rules of conduct and procedures for city meetings. Stephens motioned to approve the draft; Neuhaus seconded. All ayes- motion carried. The rules of conduct and procedure for city meetings will be posted on the bulletin board at the Shueyville Community Center.
- C. Mayor Coonfare has appointed Roger Neuhaus to be on the Board of Adjustments.
- D. Clarification on E911 signs: Residents are responsible for ordering E911 sign for their property. E911 signs can be ordered directly through the City Clerk for \$40. This includes new and replacement signs.
- E. Council discussed Swisher youth basketball league practicing at Shueyville Community Center and agreed to waive rental fees.

- Lacy removed a dead tree from the front yard of the community center and suggested allowing the construction of a little free library in its place.
- Spring housekeeping projects at the community center were discussed.
