

## Shueyville City Council Meeting – April 11, 2023

Mayor Coonfare called the regular monthly meeting of the Shueyville City Council to order at 6:30pm on Tuesday, April 11, 2023, in the council chambers at the Shueyville Community Center.

**Roll Call** – Council present in chambers: Mickey Coonfare, Brent Foss, Bart Frisk, Becky Neuhaus, Patty Stephens, Chris Lacy.

**Consent Agenda:** No comments. Neuhaus motioned to approve the consent agenda; Frisk seconded. All ayes- motion carried.

**Public Comments, Items not on Agenda:** None.

### Business:

- A. Prairie art teacher, Jason, presented students' ideas for the mural at Shuey's Restaurant. The students came up with a postcard concept. The City Council reviewed several samples of artwork for the wall and shared their feedback. The students will now complete a mock-up of the design for the wall.
- B. Budget Adoption for FY24
  1. **Public Hearing:** Neuhaus motioned to open the public hearing for budget adoption for FY24, Lacy seconded. No comments from the public. Neuhaus motioned to close the public hearing, Frisk seconded.
  2. **Resolution 2023-04:** Lacy motioned to approve Resolution 2023-04 to adopt the FY 24 budget, Neuhaus seconded. Roll Call vote: 5-0. The resolution was approved.
- C. Knox Box ordinance
  1. **Public Hearing:** Lacy motioned to open the public hearing to amend the Knox Box ordinance, Foss seconded. No comments from the public. Neuhaus motioned to close the public hearing, Frisk seconded.
  2. **Ordinance 2023-01:** Foss motioned to approve the first reading of Ordinance 2023-01 amending the city Knox Box ordinance, Stephens seconded. Roll call vote: 5-0. The first reading was approved. Lacy motioned to waive the second and third readings of Ordinance 2023-01, Neuhaus seconded. Roll call vote: 5-0. The second and third readings of Ordinance 2023-01 were waived. Final passage of the ordinance was approved and will be in effect upon publication in The Gazette.
- D. Water tank ordinance
  1. **Public Hearing:** Lacy motioned to open the public hearing to amend the water tank ordinance, Neuhaus seconded. No comments from the public. Neuhaus motioned to close the public hearing, Frisk seconded.
  2. **Ordinance 2023-02:** Frisk motioned to approve the first reading of Ordinance 2023-02 amending the city water tank ordinance, Foss seconded. Roll call vote: 5-0. The first reading was approved. Neuhaus motioned to waive the second and third readings of Ordinance 2023-02, Foss seconded. Roll call vote: 5-0. The second and third readings of Ordinance 2023-02 were waived. Final passage of the ordinance was approved and will be in effect upon publication in The Gazette.
- E. Solar Energy Systems ordinance

1. **Public Hearing:** Neuhaus motioned to open the public hearing to amend city code to add a solar energy systems ordinance, Foss seconded. No comments from the public. Foss motioned to close the public hearing, Stephens seconded.
  2. **Ordinance 2023-03:** City Engineer, Dave Schechinger, confirmed his review of the the ordinance. Frisk motioned to approve the first reading of Ordinance 2023-03 amending City Code to add a Solar Energy System ordinance, Neuhaus seconded. Roll call vote: 5-0. The first reading was approved. Lacy motioned to waive the second and third readings of Ordinance 2023-03, Neuhaus seconded. Roll call vote: 5-0. The second and third readings of Ordinance 2023-03 were waived. Final passage of the ordinance was approved and will be in effect upon publication in The Gazette.
- F. Budget Amendments for FY23
1. **Public Hearing:** Neuhaus motioned to open the public hearing for budget amendments for FY23, Frisk seconded. No comments from the public. Neuhaus motioned to close the public hearing, Foss seconded.
  2. **Resolution 2023-05:** Stephens motioned to approve Resolution 2023-05 to amend the FY 23 budget, Frisk seconded. Roll Call vote: 5-0. The resolution was approved.
- G. Water Street Bridge inspection and load rating agreement with Veenstra & Kimm was discussed. Terms of the agreement include a fee of \$1000 and completion by June. Neuhaus motioned to approve the agreement, Lacy seconded. All ayes- motion caried.
- H. Reimbursement for deer carcass removal from a city street by a Shueyville resident was discussed. Neuhaus motioned to approve reimbursement to match the last deer carcass removal fee the city incurred; Frisk seconded. All ayes, motion carried.
